- Reviewed Feedback from Armed Forces Parade at State Fair. CMDR White led discussion that Parade at the State Fair has not produced members to the base and that fair attendees run in between vehicles creating safety concerns. The base will discuss next year whether to continue to attend the parade.
- The next parade is scheduled for Veterans Day, 11 November, at the State Fairgrounds. Treasurer Strong has volunteered to be Lead coordinator for that parade. Details will be announced at the next meeting.
- Ed Hyne questioned if there should be an Operational Procedure for Parades. CMDR White said that based on the small number of parades and that current attendees are the normal attendees, that a written procedure wasn't necessary.
- Also discussed was handing out miniature flags while participating in parades. Miniature flags are possible, and costs could be offset by donations from a VFW or other Veterans group. Discussions on flags at parades will continue in future meetings.
